### **Mini Track: Knowledge Management for Resilient Enterprise**

The essence of the resilient enterprise is the ability to recover from disruptions, disasters, crisis, hazardous situations and uncertainties by creating effective redundancy, modularity and flexibility within an enterprise or organisation. Therefore new knowledge management approaches are required to support the development and operation of the resilient enterprise. These new approaches should be defined through the joint efforts of researchers, and knowledge management practitioners in order to coherently develop realistic knowledge strategies linked to the realities of the contemporary society and global economy. This mini track aims at providing to researchers and practitioners the latest relevant and effective knowledge management approaches for resilient enterprises and organisations that will contribute to the sustainability in uncertain times. Papers are solicited on theories as well as practices or applications.

Possible topics include, but are not limited to:

- Knowledge, complexity, risk, emergence and resilience
- Resilient knowledge management systems
- Resilience, knowledge, trust and security
- Information security and knowledge protection
- Knowledge Management for resilient supply chains
- Agile and resilient enterprise knowledge
- Resilient networked enabled systems
- Other topics

**Abstract details:** The Abstract should be a minimum of 300 and no more than 500 words including up to five keywords and keyphrases to be received by **12 February 2010**. Please read the abstract guidelines section of the website before submitting.

**Full paper:** Only required when the abstract has been selected and not to be more than 5,000 words including abstract, keywords and references (the Harvard referencing rules need to be followed). Submission date will be no later than **2 April**

The selection panel of the conference committee will consider all abstracts received by the submission deadline to ensure that the proposed paper is relevant to the Conference. The authors of abstracts that describe a relevant paper will receive a notification of abstract selection. All full papers will be double-blind reviewed by members of the conference committee to ensure an adequate standard, that the proposed subject of their abstract has been followed, that the paper is of a suitable length, the standard of English is adequate and the paper is appropriately referenced. For authors whose first language is not English we request that you have your work proofread preferably by a native English speaker prior to submission (or at least a fluent English speaker) – papers may be rejected due to a poor standard of English. Papers that are accepted will be published in the conference proceedings providing at least one author registers and presents the work at the Conference (see the registration section of the conference website for more information about registration).

Due to the large number of papers expected for this conference, the committee only allows an author to present one paper. Therefore if multiple papers are accepted for presentation different co-authors need to present each paper.
