Keynote Outline:

e-Learning has sometimes been criticized as lacking the ‘human’ element and often being simply a one-way information transmission method. However, recent changes that have been occurring in face-to-face contexts from teacher-directed to student-centered learning can inform our practice in e-Learning.

Many active and interactive methods for enhancing learning are available such as problem-based and case-based learning, cooperative learning structures, inquiry learning, games, simulations, online labs, and communities of practice. These methods will be described with examples given of their use in e-Learning contexts.
