Enterprise Risk Management, risk control, risk measurement and governance are needing better strategic knowledge, customer knowledge, operational knowledge, logistic knowledge. This track look for research contribution to the development of the capacity in the organization to integrate, coordinate, share and create knowledge for better risk management practice

Research issues as follows are of special interest:

- Integration of Knowledge Management Systems and Risk Management Systems
- Development of metrics and performance evaluation systems that include risk as a priority to analyze and provide scope of decisions
- Learn how to transfer risk knowledge, how to develop means to communicate effectively and to develop enterprise capacity in analytics and interdisciplinary work
- Issues of risk management in the society, how to deal with factors affecting the organizations
- What is the purpose of forecasting and risk orientation in the knowledge development
- Creating culture around knowledge and risk, identification of strategic drivers, construction of risk indicators, managing risk tools, developing early warning systems, managing assumptions in the modelling process, understanding the outcomes of the modelling process, etc
- Risk Knowledge creation, how to develop capacity for the enterprise based on a better understanding of risk
- Developing intellectual capital in geographical regions in order to solve problems associated with the communities
- Intellectual capital as a development of the mindset of the organizations to use knowledge to control risk and to create knowledge when risk appear Other topics
- Risk of innovation and the need of innovation with controlled risk
- Organization of risk management groups, capacity of work coordination and development of conjoint work
- The gap that exists between the board and management in the field of risk management. How to use governance models to improve the risk knowledge management

Full paper: Only required when the abstract has been selected and not to be more than 5,000 words including abstract, keywords and references (the Harvard referencing rules need to be followed). Submission date will be no later than **10 June 2010**. Papers should be submitted as .doc or .rtf file attachments by email to the Conference Manager, Elaine Hayne at [Elaine.hayne@academic-conferences.org](mailto:Elaine.hayne@academic-conferences.org)

The selection panel of the conference committee will consider all abstracts received by the submission deadline to ensure that the proposed paper is relevant to the Conference. The authors of abstracts that describe a relevant paper will receive a notification of abstract selection. All full papers will be double-blind reviewed by members of the conference committee to ensure an adequate standard, that the proposed subject of their abstract has been followed, that the paper is of a suitable length, the standard of English is adequate and the paper is appropriately referenced. For authors whose first language is not English we request that you have your work proofread preferably by a native English speaker prior to submission (or at least a fluent English speaker) – papers may be rejected due to a poor standard of English. Papers that are accepted will be published in the conference proceedings providing at least one author registers and presents the work at the Conference (see the registration section of the conference website for more information about registration).

Due to the large number of papers expected for this conference, the committee only allows an author to present one paper. Therefore if multiple papers are accepted for presentation different co-authors need to present each paper. 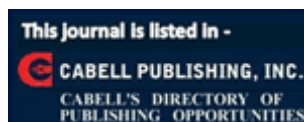
