### Mini Track on Management and Evaluation of Accounting Information Systems: State of Art and Future Trends

Mini Track Co-Chair: Daniela Mancini, Eusebio Scornavacca, Nicola Castellano and Rita Lamboglia



The aim of this Accounting Information Systems mini-track is to analyse how companies can manage and evaluate accounting and management information systems. These systems should enhance information potential, develop decision making abilities; improve both accounting methodologies and performance measurement systems. Contributions can cover different phases of the information process such as data management (data collection, data processing and sharing of a large amount of data); information systems architecture (which refers to the structure of the information system, the integration and consistency of its components), external and internal reporting or auditing activities on IS/IT. This mini-track places a special attention on papers concerning the evaluation of AIS when companies adopt new technology including social networks, digital platforms, digital technologies, XBRL, and Internet of Things. Such topics can be related to different contexts and industries: private and public companies; small, medium and large companies; companies and inter-organisational relations. Theoretical and empirical studies are equally encouraged, as well as literature reviews.

Papers that deals with management and evaluation issues related to the following topics, are welcome:

- financial reporting and communications;
- reputation measurement systems
- business intelligence and control processes
- performance measurement systems in smart contexts
- transparency and information systems in the public sector
- voluntary disclosure and ICT
- sustainability reporting and integrated reporting

She received her Ph.D. from the same University and has been a visiting fellow at Université Catholique de Louvain (UCL) and at Université catholique de Lille. Her research interests are on IS, internal control systems and IT audit.



**Nicola Giuseppe Castellano** is an Associate Professor of Management at the Department of Economics and Law University of Macerata (Italy). He holds a PhD in Management from the University of Pisa. His main research interests are in the field of management accounting focusing on: management control systems, performance management systems and information systems.
