Mini Track on Knowledge Transfer as an Element of Enterprise Security

Mini Track Chair: Dr Justyna Zywiłek & Joanna Rosak-Szyrocka, Czestochowa University of Technology, Poland



Knowledge exchange between "new" and "old" employees is often causes a problems. An additional difficulty is when this transfer takes place in a professional group or supply chain among employees where, for example, the industry has a large turnover. Businesses need to develop methods to aid in this process. This mini-track will deal with both the barriers and the positives of such knowledge transfers. Exchange of experiences in the field of enterprise security systems is particularly important and difficult.

Theoretical, as well as practical contributions, are invited to this mini track. Potential topics include, but are not limited to:

- Staff turnover as a threat to the exchange of experience in the field of security
- Security policy as the basis for building a big data system about enterprise security
- Mapping the information value stream as a way to manage knowledge
- Enterprise security threats and knowledge exchange
- Knowledge exchange quality management tools supporting enterprise security



Justyna Żywiłek is a doctor of engineering at the Faculty of Management of the Czestochowa University of Technology. It deals with the management of information and knowledge, and their security. He is also a personal data protection inspector and an auditor of the ISO 27000 standard. He is also interested in the use of Big Data, Internet of Things for security management systems. He is guest editor of many international magazines. He is the co-author of over 150 publications, including articles published in peer-reviewed journals, book chapters, conference materials, and research

reports.



Dr Joanna Rosak-Szyrocka, is a Lecturer at Czestochowa University of Technology in Poland, the Vice President of the Qualitas Foundation and a member of the Polish ISO 9000 Forum Club. Joanna has author/co-authored 221 scientific publications in prestigious journals, chapters in monographs and conference materials as well as co-authoring 20 scientific monographs. She has been a participant of the Erasmus + international exchange, during which she conducted a series of international lectures in England, Slovenia, Slovakia and Italy.
